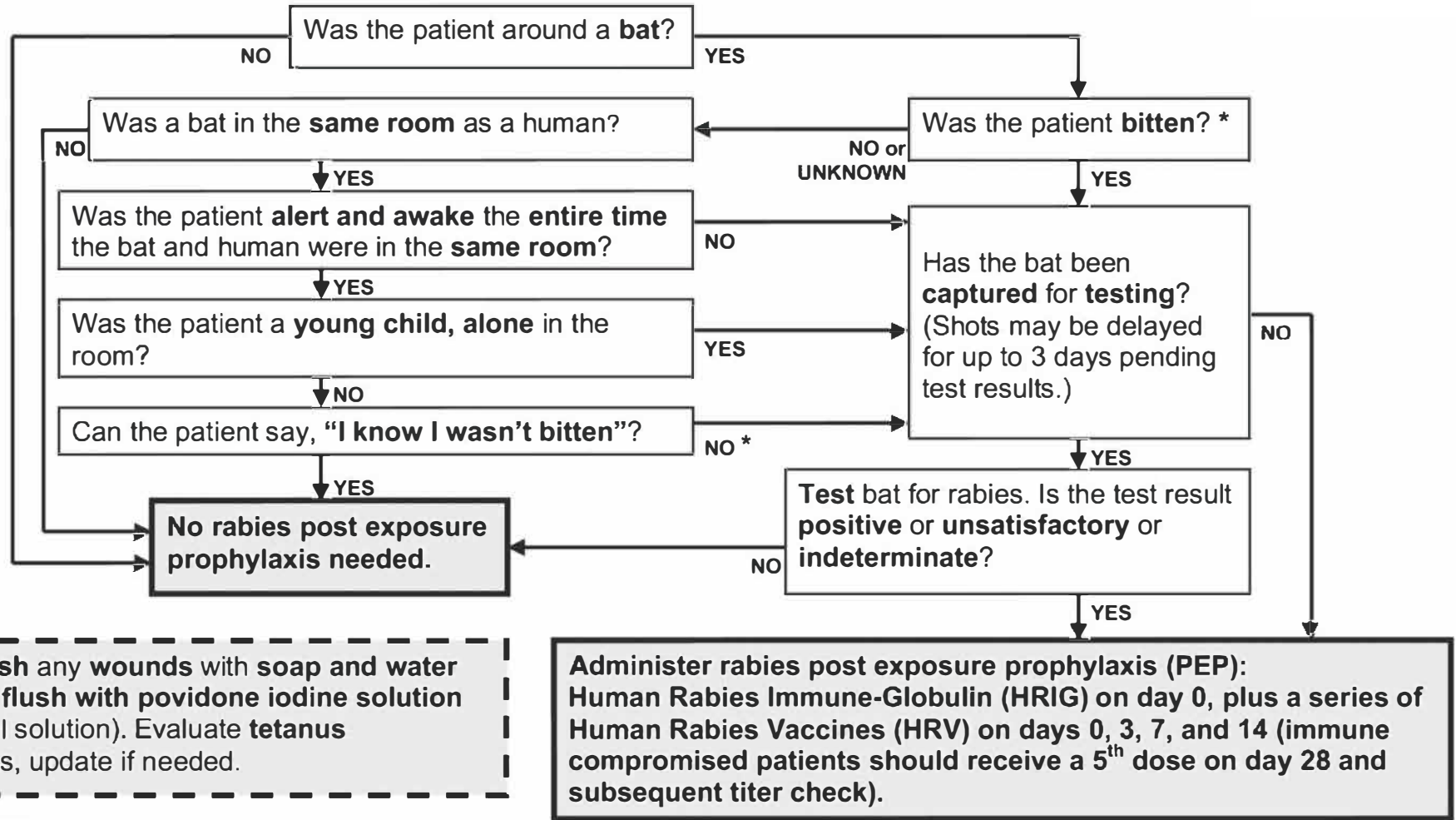


# Rabies Exposure Management for Bat-related Incidents



\* Thoroughly **wash** any wounds with **soap and water** and, if available, **flush with povidone iodine solution** (or other virucidal solution). Evaluate **tetanus** vaccination status, update if needed.

**Administer rabies post exposure prophylaxis (PEP):** Human Rabies Immune-Globulin (HRIG) on day 0, plus a series of Human Rabies Vaccines (HRV) on days 0, 3, 7, and 14 (immune compromised patients should receive a 5<sup>th</sup> dose on day 28 and subsequent titer check).
