## **COVID-19 Boosters and Seasonal Flu Vaccines Available**

KEARNEY – Two Rivers Public Health Department encourages all citizens to vaccinate themselves for the coming cold and flu season. Two Rivers Public Health Department is now able to administer all types of COVID-19 booster vaccines and flu vaccines.

CDC recommends everyone stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccination, including all primary series doses and boosters for their age group: ages 6 months through 4 years should get all COVID-19 primary series doses, ages 5 years and older should get all primary series doses, and updated COVID-19 boosters if eligible. Getting a COVID-19 vaccine after you recover from COVID-19 infection provides added protection against COVID-19. People who are moderately or severely immunocompromised have [different recommendations for COVID-19 vaccines](#), including boosters. For people ages 12 years and older, the only authorized mRNA booster is the updated (bivalent) booster. People ages 12 years and older can no longer get the original (monovalent) mRNA booster. [COVID-19 vaccine and booster recommendations](#) may be updated as CDC continues to monitor the latest data.

Flu vaccines for individuals 6 months old to 64 years old, and high dose flu vaccines for individuals 65+ are available.

COVID-19 vaccines available through Two Rivers Public Health Department are:

- Primary and booster Pfizer vaccine
- Primary and booster Moderna vaccine
- Novavax vaccine
