


Risk Dial Sep 17 2020



Risk Dial for COVID-19 Two Rivers Public Health Published September 17, 2020

- The district's overall positivity rate increased from 11 to 13% over the past week, and the total number of cases recorded a significant increase.
- There has been an increase in hospitalization rates overall, although COVIDrelated hospitalizations remain stable compared to the previous week. Ventilator use has remained about the same, there is no sign of any undue strain on equipment.
- 50-59 (pos rt 19.4%) and 70-79 year olds (20.9%) in the district showed increasing positivity rates; severity of disease is not currently captured by the risk dial model.
- There were 3 deaths reported in Two Rivers Health District over the past week. This follows reports of two more deaths (including a 20 year old male) the previous week in the district.
- Testing coverage for the district is adequate to meet demand, with scheduled open timings for TestNebraska sites at all locations functional across the health district.
- Since March to date, around 250 tests have been conducted per 1000 persons in Two Rivers Health District, ranging from 294/1000 in Dawson to 110/1000 in Harlan county.

Overall testing – previous week

A total of 1147 persons were tested in the past week, of whom 149 were positive, and 998 were negative. The results are displayed below.











The following graph describes the 7-day rolling average of cases per county for the last 4 weeks.





Weekly summary

- The numbers above depict the total persons tested over the past week and the past 4 weeks in Two Rivers Health District along with positivity rates. Also displayed are the proportion of tests performed per county, per age category and for males v/s females.
- Over half of all tests were conducted by TestNebraska, and people living in Kearney and Phelps county accounted for over an eighth of all tests conducted in the past week
- Buffalo and Dawson counties account for a bulk of the positive results received over the past week. Although Gosper county shows an increased positivity rate (37.5%), this represents a total of 6 positive cases out of 16 persons tested. Elwood, with a positivity rate over 35% is largely driving this increase
- The increase in cases in most small towns over the past few weeks seems to have abated for now. Of these, only Gibbon (positivity rate 35%) and Holdrege (pos rate 15.5%) warrant close monitoring for now.
- A fourth of all tests in Kearney city in the past week were administered to persons aged 18-29 years, and they returned a positivity rate of 15%, almost identical to the previous week. Adults aged 18-23 years accounted for three quarters of these cases, as the positivity rates among college students and others aged 18-23 remain high (22%) in Kearney city
- Age profile of positive cases is a cause for concern. Rising positivity rates among 50-59 (pos rt 19.4%) and 70-79 year olds (20.9%) in the district is worrying. These cases seem to be residents of cities like Gibbon and Minden in addition to Kearney city.
- There were 3 deaths due to COVID reported in Two Rivers Health District over the past week. This follows reports of two more deaths (including a 20 year old male) the previous week in the district.
