

COVID-19 Vaccine Doses Dispensed in Two Rivers Health District (by County): Dec 15 - Mar 15

The three graphs depict the current status of COVID-19 vaccination in Two Rivers Public Health District (TRPHD) as of March 16, 2021. This includes residents of Buffalo, Dawson, Franklin, Gosper, Harlan, Kearney & Phelps counties (97,132)

- Graphs 1 & 2 show relative number of **residents of each county** who have received one or two shots of the vaccine.
 - Graph 1 shows the number of eligible persons (16 + years) per county, and orders the
 counties by decreasing percentage of persons who received one or two doses of the
 vaccine.
 - Graph 2 shows the number of persons aged 65+ years in the district, and orders each
 county by decreasing percentage of persons who received one dose and those fully
 vaccinated.
- **Graph 3** shows the age distribution of all male and female residents of TRPHD who are fully vaccinated.


Key Takeaways

- 1. Among Health Departments in Nebraska, TRPHD has vaccinated the highest proportion of its eligible population; as of March 16, over 18% of the district's eligible population had been fully vaccinated. This is 20% higher than the Statewide average.
- 2. Over half the residents of Buffalo, Kearney and Dawson counties who are aged 65 years or more have been fully vaccinated. Almost 80% of 65+ residents living in Buffalo county have been vaccinated at least once.
- 3. Proportion of eligible population that has been fully vaccinated ranges from 23% in Kearney county to Phelps county at 13%. Over 30% of eligible residents of the district have been vaccinated at least once.
- 4. Women account for almost 2/3rd of all fully vaccinated residents of TRPHD; women outnumber men at all age groups among fully vaccinated residents.
- 5. Some part of the gender gap in the under 65 group may be explained by the over-representation of women in specific professions that received vaccine early, like healthcare and education. Similarly, women outnumber men in the 65+ age group in Two Rivers Health District, which may explain some part of the gender difference in vaccination rates among seniors
