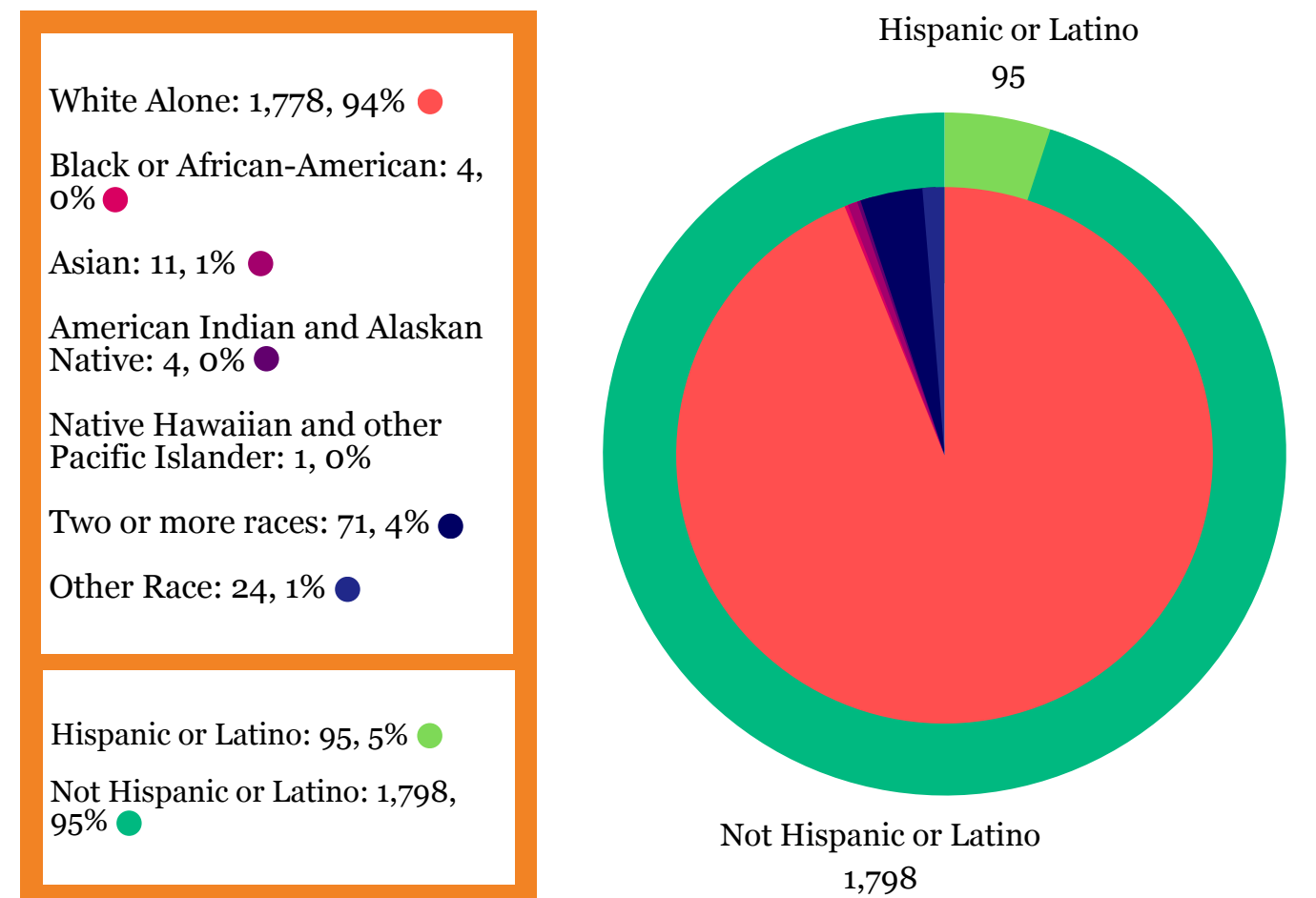


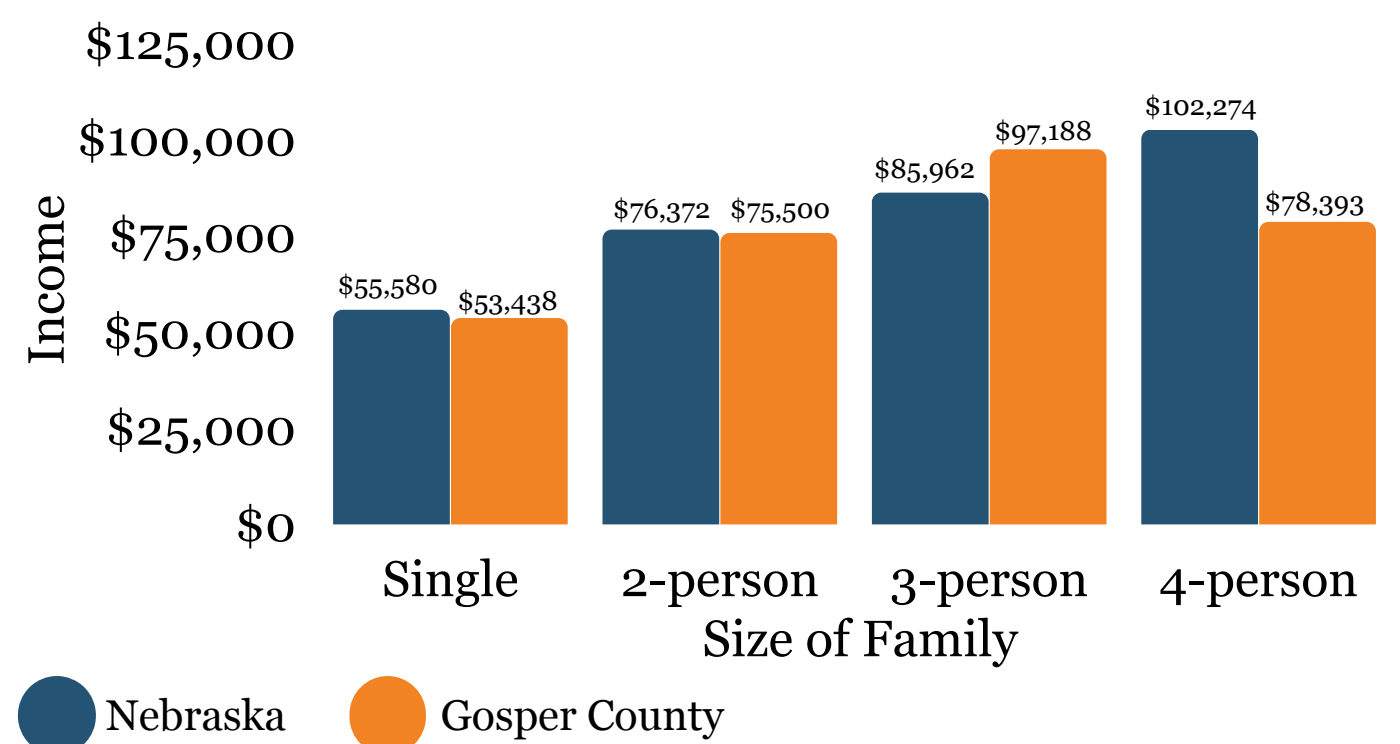

Population of Gosper County, by Race/Ethnicity



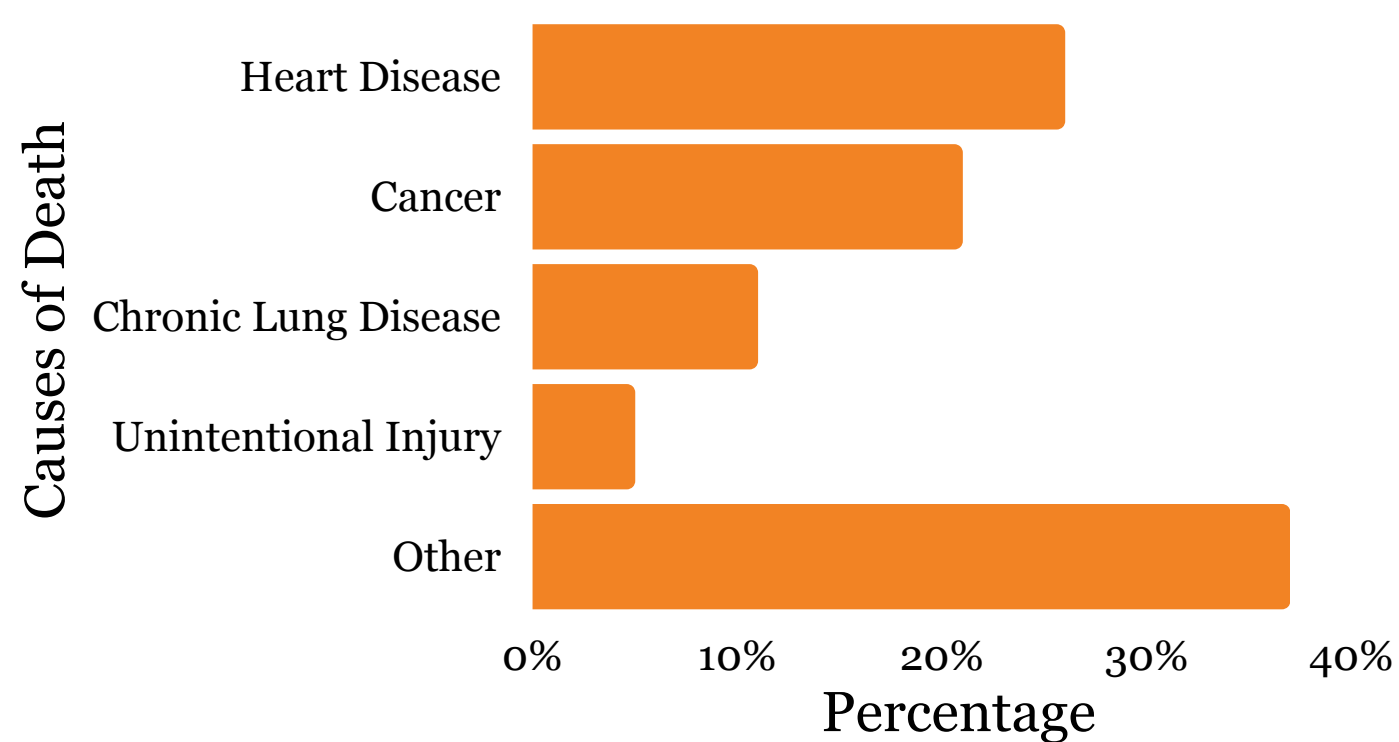
Median Income, per Family Size

With a median age of 54 years, Gosper is the second oldest County in Nebraska. With less than 2000 residents, it is also the 8th smallest County in Nebraska. The largest cities are Elwood (county seat) and Smithfield. Johnson Lake, one of the largest recreational lake areas in the State is partly within Gosper County. Residential communities around Johnson Lake often consist of a sizeable population that may live for part of the year in Gosper County.
